I. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

In line with its entrusted missions to provide supervision, accompaniment and socio-economic integration for young Cameroonians to enable them to participate in nation building, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education (MINJEC) has signed a Partnership Agreement with the PHILJOHN CARES Association, in order to accompany the socio-economic integration of young people in the digital field. This Partnership Agreement seeks to contribute to the development of human capital through quality training, as well as providing access to and use of a range of products and services tailored to the technological and digital ecosystem.

It is in line with the a implementation momentum of the aforementioned Partnership Agreement that training in the digital field is being offered to young people at the Vocational Training Centre Philjohn Academy (CFP-PJT ACADEMY).

Hence the launch of this Call for Applications for the selection of three hundred (300) young Cameroonians wishing to be trained in the field in question.

II. PURPOSE OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

This Call for Applications is for the selection of three hundred (300) young Cameroonians for training in the digital field at the Vocational Training Centre Philjohn Academy, and their placement in direct indirect employment with PHILJOHN CARES and its network of partners, as well as in self-employment in the digital professions after training.

III. ELIGIBILITY CRIETRIA

Youths who fulfil the following conditions may apply:

- be of Cameroonian nationality;
- be aged between 18 and 35 years at the time of application;
- be a holder of the Youth Biometric Card or receipt of subscription;

- be a holder of a GCE ordinary level passed in attest 4 papers except religious studies or any other equivalent certificate
- be unemployed or in a precarious economic situation.

IV. COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

All application files should include the following documents:

- a stamped application addressed to the Minister;
- two (02) 4x4 photos;
- a copy of the required certificate;
- a photocopy of the National Identity Card or receipt thereof, where applicable;
- a detailed curriculum vitae (CV);
- a copy of the Biometric Youth Card or the receipt thereof.

V. <u>DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FILES</u>

Application files must be submitted no later than Monday 31 march 2025:

- either physically, in a sealed envelope, at 3:30 p.m., at the Mail Service of the Head Office building of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education, located at the Administrative Centre, opposite the National Archives, or in Regional, Divisional and Subdivisional Multipurpose Youth Empowerment Centres;
- or online (digital copy), at 11.59 p.m., at the following address: https://www.philjohncares.org/jobs/philjohn-excellency-program-2025-cameroun-34.

The sealed envelopes containing files must be bear the words:

"FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF THREE HUNDRED (300) YOUTHS FOR TRAINING IN THE DIGITAL SECTOR".

VI. SELECTION PROCEDURES

Submitted application files will be examined by a Jury and the selected candidates will receive one (01) online training followed by an aptitude test. The best three hundred (300) candidates will receive online and face-to-face training for a period of three (03) months.

At the end of which the best 30 (thirty) candidates will be recruited directly by the PHILIOHN TECH partner, while one hundred and fifty (150) will be placed in indirect jobs in a network of PHILIOHN CARES partners and the remaining one hundred and twenty (120) will receive financial support to engage in self-employment.

Selected candidates will be informed by posting and/or electronically.
