## I. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

Following the Very High Agreement of the President of the Republic and at the invitation of YUNUS SA, an interministerial delegation (PRC, MINREX, MINJEC, and AMBACAM BRUXELLES) held talks in the Kingdom of Belgium from 24 February to 03 March 2025. The purpose of the mission was, to close the Youth Month in the Diaspora on the one hand, and on the other hand, to mobilise Technical Financial Partners to support the empowerment of Cameroonian youths through self-employment

In keeping with its devolved missions to promote national integration, and more specifically to supervise and accompany local initiatives of Cameroonians in the Diaspora to enable them participate in nation building, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education (MINJEC) during this mission, signed a tripartite partnership agreement with YUNUS S.A and PEOPLE Finance S.A. (PEFI). The purpose of the Partnership Agreement is to accompany the socio-economic integration of Cameroonian youths.

The purpose of this agreement is to provide young Cameroonians with vehicles to be used as township taxis through financial leases/sales contracts on the one hand, and, to enable them come up with income-generating activities (IGAs) on the other Hence the reason of the launch of this Call for Applications for the selection of fifty (50) young Cameroonians willing to benefit from an opportunity in the township taxis transport sector.

## II. PURPOSE OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The purpose of this Call for Applications is to select fifty (50) young Cameroonians to be accompanied in their integration into the township taxi transport sector.

#### III. ELIGIBILITY CRIETRIA

Youths who fulfil the following criteria may apply:

- be of Cameroonian nationality;
- be aged between 17 and 35 years at the time of application;

- be aged between 17 and 35 years at the time of application;
- live in Cameroon:
- be registered with the National Youth Observatory (NYO):
- be a holder of the Biometric Youth Card;
- be unemployed or in a precarious economic situation;
- be a holder of a category B driving licence;
- Commit to using the rolling stock exclusively for professional purposes and comply with the conditions set out in the initiative;
- be in good physical condition: good health, good eyesight, good hearing and good mobility.

## IV. COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

Candidates' application files must include the following documents:

- a stamped application addressed to the Minister of Youth Affairs and Civic Education;
- a photocopy of the National Identity Card or valid receipt thereof, where applicable;
- a photocopy of category B driving licence;
- a Biometric Youth Card or a receipt thereof;
- a map locating the young applicant's home.

# V. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FILES

Application files must be submitted no later than Friday, 06 June 2025:

- either physically, in a sealed envelope, at 3:30 p.m., at the Mail Service of the Head Office building of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education, located at the Administrative Centre, opposite the National Archives, or at the Regional, Divisional and Subdivisional Multipurpose Youth Empowerment Centres;

#### VI. SELECTION CRITERIA

The applications received will first be pre-selected by the competent services of MINJEC. The pre-selected applications will then be examined by a joint Selection Committee, made up of



representatives appointed for this purpose by MINJEC and representatives of YUNUS and PEOPLE Finance S.A. This Committee will evaluate the applicants and determine the final beneficiaries, in strict compliance with the selection criteria defined in this call for applications. At the end of this indepth examination, successful candidates will be informed of the Selection Committee's decision by posting and/or electronically.
