The Minister of Youth Affairs and Civic Education hereby informs Cameroonian youths at home and in the Diaspora that the deadline for the submission of the Call for Projects for the financing of thirty (30) projects by young entrepreneurs in the Diaspora, in joint venture with their local peers under the partnership agreements between financial institutions and MINJEC, through the Young Entrepreneur Guarantee Fund (FOGAJEUNE) implementation project, originally slated for Sunday, 13 October 2024, has now been extended to **Friday, 29 November 2024 at precisely 3:30 pm.**

Furthermore, following the signing of the Partnership Agreement between MINJEC, YUNUS S.A. and NGO ODEA on 10 October 2024, the number of projects to be selected has been increased to sixty (60) i.e. thirty (30) more.
